

Christmas Parade Rules

Safety is our biggest concern due to the large number of children that will be present.

Parking of any non-parade vehicle will not be allowed on any roadway or access drive while floats are being staged for the parade. Unattended vehicles will be towed.

All parade vehicles must complete the full parade route. Follow East Main St. to the end where East Main Street meets Hwy 19 E. This will be at the Subway light. Do not cut through any of the areas including the Shell Station. Follow the parade route. On Hwy 19 E, stay in the right lane until you reach the starting area.

Parade walkers can arrange to be picked up at the end of East Main Street. If you begin the parade on a float or in a vehicle, you must remain on the float or in the vehicle until the end of the parade, no exceptions.

Anyone walking with a float or vehicle must stay with their float or vehicle, keeping with the flow of the parade, no exceptions.

Each parade vehicle/float must designate a responsible party to remain with the vehicle/float at all times. This will be the only contact person. No drivers under the age of 18.

Rules for Drivers

- Watch for children and yield to pedestrians
- Drivers must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.
- Floats must travel at a safe walking pace (3–5 mph).
- All vehicles must be in good working condition (brakes, steering, lights).

Staging & Lineup

- Participants must check in at the staging area by the designated time.
- Parade lineup order is determined by the committee and may not be changed on parade day.
- All participants must follow the directions of parade officials and volunteers.

Failure to follow these rules may result in removal from the parade
